Region	The SRS region based on the zip code listed on the LIS application.	Used to distribute the application.
KHPA/SRS Date	The date the data file was received from SSA. This is the application date for the MSP eligibility determination.	Entered in the App Received Date field.
SSA App. Date	The date the LIS application was filed with SSA. This is the proration date for the MSP eligibility determination.	Entered in the Ben Proration Date field.
Action	The result of the preliminary eligibility determination completed by SRS.	For application distribution only.
ID#	The applicant's medical identification number if already known to KAECSSES.	
Case #	The applicant's most recent medical case number if a medical program is currently open on KAECSSES.	
HH Size	The household size used for the preliminary eligibility determination (1 = applicant; 2 = applicant and spouse).	The applicant and spouse both will be registered.
MSP	The preliminary eligibility determination level of MSP – QMB, LMB, or ELMB.	
Income Pass?	The preliminary eligibility determination of countable income – “Y” indicates pass, “N” indicates fail. Also lists the countable income amount.	For application distribution only.
Resource Pass?	The preliminary eligibility determination of countable resources – “Y” indicates pass, “N” indicates fail. Also lists the countable resource amount.	For application distribution only.
Name	The first name, middle initial and last name of the applicant and spouse entered on the LIS application.	

Sex	The sex of the applicant and spouse entered on the LIS application.	
DOB/DOD	The date of birth of the applicant and spouse entered on the LIS application. The date of death of the applicant and spouse from the KDHE death record.	
SSN	The Social Security Number of the applicant and spouse entered on the LIS application.	
Medicare #	The Medicare number of the applicant and spouse entered on the LIS application.	
Address	The applicant's mailing address entered on the LIS application.	
Telephone	The applicant's telephone number entered on the LIS application.
